### **NOTES**

- 1 Sponsor provides all entertainment, signage, equipment, staff, and food. GBF provides one person to open and close and on call for emergencies.
- 2 Heating cost billed per usage; meter readings are required before and after event.
- 3 GBF provides the use of tables and chairs on site; GBF has 21 8' x 30" tables and 41 folding chairs (Party may rent additional chairs and tables from outside suppliers). One visual screen for projection is also available.
- 4 Banquest permits apply.
- 5 GBF event staff will meet with the party and tour the facilities. A list of vendors will be provided for services and equipment rental needed. The party will make their own arrangements. Set up/take down responsibility of lessee.
- 6 Set up can be as early as 8 AM. Take down commences by 11:00PM.
- 7 Rental equipment may be delivered on Friday and picked up on Monday at no additional charge.
- 8 On site staff person provided. Set up/take down responsibility of lessee.
- 9 Staff person will be present to speak with the audience about the farm and give them the opportunity to contribute.
- 10 Non-profit agencies must provide certificate of 501C3 and insurance.
