**RESOLUTION NO. 239**

**A RESOLUTION of the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Coupeville, Island County, Washington, to adopt the Job Description for the Position of Facilities Maintenance Technician.**

**WHEREAS**, the Port of Coupeville is a special purpose district established under the laws of the State of Washington, and

**WHEREAS**, the Port of Coupeville has the authority to adopt the Job Description for the Full-Time position of Facilities Maintenance Technician; and

**WHEREAS**, the Port of Coupeville has determined it is necessary to establish and maintain a set of policies, practices, skills and procedures to ensure the effective and efficient management of the Port of Coupeville assets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Facilities Maintenance Technician was given the opportunity to provide feedback on the Job Description, and the Facilities Maintenance Technician indicated they had no specific concerns; and


**WHEREAS**, the Port of Coupeville has determined it is desirable and in the public interest to adopt the Job Description to address employment and personnel matters that apply to the Facilities Maintenance Technician position; and

**WHEREAS**, it is expected that revisions to the employee Job Descriptions will be made periodically and employees will receive revisions upon Board of Commissioner approval; and,


**WHEREAS**, the Job Description for the position of Full-Time Facilities Maintenance Technician as attached hereto be and the same is hereby adopted.




