Thank you for your patience, and as you probably know – contractors on the island are very busy and Wharf work requires highly specialized skills given the historic preservation standards we adhere to.

The Wharf cap & piles project is (still) waiting for a permit from the National Marine Fisheries

Service. We're entering our third year, so hopeful we will be able to move forward soon.
