

Roger Purdue Exhibit at Island County Historical Museum

The legacy of Roger Purdue is evident in several places on the Coupeville Wharf. A highlight of his artistic career was the "Spirits of the Salmon" wheel, which was originally displayed at the base of the Wharf. In 2011, it was replaced with the Whale Whorl Wheel, designed by Purdue and carved by community artists in 2011. Stop by and give it a spin!

The Salmon Wheel is now on display in the museum exhibit. Five different salmon on the wheel represent the five species that live in this area. The wheel commemorates the importance and spirituality of the salmon and the environment; the circle and its ability to spin represent the cycle of life.

Purdue's artistic legacy is also memorialized on Penn Cove Water Festival posters. Many are displayed in the Coupeville Wharf foyer.

Port of Coupeville Working With Island County to Own AJ Eisenberg Airport

The Port of Coupeville met with the Board of Island County Commissioners to

discuss the purchase and operation of the AJ Eisenberg Airport, a now-private airport located just south of Oak Harbor. The Board of County Commissioners went into executive session to consider the acquisition of real estate by lease or purchase (RCW 42.30.110(1)(b)). The Board came back into session and passed a motion directing staff to negotiate purchase of the Eisenberg Airport within the parameters discussed in executive session.


