8. OLD BUSINESS

8.1 Discussion: Wharf Update - Roof & Pile Projects

Executive Director Michalopoulos provided an update on the roof & pile projects. Doug Thompson of Thompson Environmental discussed concerns, next steps and impacts on the pile/cap project.

RMC will finalize scope of work as well as plans for the wharf re-roof project in January 2023.

8.2 Discussion: Broadband Phase 2 Update

Kara Riebold with Petrichor Broadband provided an update on the project, plans and next steps. The next steps will be to obtain engineering designs through a request for proposal (RFP), and an IRU agreement between the Port of Coupeville and an Internet Service Provider (ISP).

9. NEW BUSINESS

9.1 Introduction: Wharf UST Replacement Project

Executive Director Michalopoulos provided an update on the Wharf UST (Underground Storage Tank) replacement project. A bid has been received to give an idea of replacement costs. Commissioner Day inquired on the life expectancy of new tanks, warranty, and whether we can utilize smaller tanks to reduce costs.

9.2 Introduction: Greenbank Farm Phase 3 Lighting – Stadium Lights

Executive Director Michalopoulos introduced an approximate replacement cost of 7 stadium lights positioned over the grass event/parking area of the Greenbank Farm. Three bids are being sought. Commissioner Day would like to review costs of renting lights for events vs replacement.

9.3 Discussion: Airport Project Update

Commissioner Mishasek discussed further options to purchase the Eisenburg Airport through a study. The Board discussed how they will collectively communicate with interested citizens.

10. PUBLIC COMMENT

11. COMMISSIONER DISCUSSION

Commissioner Mishasek requested the projects page on the website be updated with both the Broadband and Wharf Pile Project.

Commissioner Day would like to know how interested the POC Board is on working to expand its current boundaries.

Commissioner Day has a meeting scheduled with Dave Paul December 5, 2022, and would like to know our top talking points. He plans to discuss the airport project, extension of expiration dates on upcoming grants, and grants for barns A and B at the Greenbank Farm. Commissioner Mishasek would like discussions on workforce housing.

Commissioner Callahan would like to know the priorities for the Port's capital improvement and CR&M projects list. Commissioner Day suggested Commissioner Callahan and Executive Director Michalopoulos collaborate on a project list to set priorities.
