8. FINANCIAL UPDATE

8.1 Financial Update – Accountant Wilson provided an update of accounts and reporting of levy funds.

9. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR REPORT

Executive Director Michalopoulos gave an update of the Greenbank Farm and the Coupeville Wharf. He reported that preventative actions taken prior to the windstorms have only resulted in minor storm damages. He reported a theft in the tractor barn where a welder and several tools were taken. The needs for a generator to support the main office, which also supports the alarm system at the tractor barn, were discussed. This was previously suggested by Commissioner Callahan to prevent disruptions to operations during power outages.

10. OLD BUSINESS

10.1 Discussion: Wharf Update

Executive Director Michalopoulos gave an update on the wharf re-roof project. He explained where we are in the permitting process as well as the need to present the case for metal roof shingles to the historic preservation commission on November 17, 2022.

10.2 Discussion: Broadband Phase 2 Update

The Public Works Board contract has been executed. There are many administrative tasks needing completion to satisfy the contract before any work begins. This includes additional insurance requirements for theft liability.

10.3 Action: 2023 Budget Approval

The Board has extensively reviewed the budget with no current objections or requests to edit. Commissioner Day moved to approve the 2023 budget. Commissioner Mishasek made a motion to approve 2023 Budget. Seconded by Commissioner Callahan. **Motion was passed unanimously.**

10.4 Action: Resolution #296 – 2023 Budget Levy Approval

Commissioner Mishasek made a motion to approve Resolution #296. Commissioner Day seconded. **Motion was passed unanimously.**

10.5 Action: Resolution #294 – Collection of an Industrial Development District (IDD) Levy for 2023

Resolution #294 is approving the collection amount of IDD taxes by the County. Commissioner Mishasek made a motion to approve Resolution #294. Commissioner Callahan seconded. **Motion was passed unanimously.**

10.6 Action: Resolution #297 – 2023 IDD Levy Approval

Resolution #297 is the worksheet that will be submitted to Island County. Commissioner Day made a motion to approve Resolution #297. Seconded by Commissioner Mishasek. **Motion was passed unanimously.**

10.7 Action: Resolution #293 – Amending the Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements 2022 2023

Commissioner Mishasek made a motion to approve Resolution #293. Commissioner Day seconded. **Motion was passed unanimously.**

11. NEW BUSINESS

11.1 Introduction: Changing Meeting Time of Second Monthly OPM to 10 AM (November 23rd)

Commissioner Day requested to move the meeting on November 23rd to 11 AM instead of 10 AM due to attendance at the COG meeting. The Board will have more discussion on permanently changing the second meeting time in December.

11.2 Action: District #3 Commissioner Officer Assignment

Commissioner Day made a motion to approve District 3 Commissioner Callahan as Secretary of the Board of Commissioners. Commissioner Mishasek seconded. **Motion was passed unanimously.**

Commissioner Mishasek attended a Skagit Valley College (SVC) meeting located at the Oak Hall. They welcomed the new SVC President Christopher Villa.

Commissioner Day attended COG Meeting on 10/26/22 that dealt with legislative tasks. Many representatives were in attendance and reviewed legislative concerns and what tasks were getting done throughout the state.

Review for other potential funding outside of IDD for infrastructure bill in relation to public safety and emergency management.
