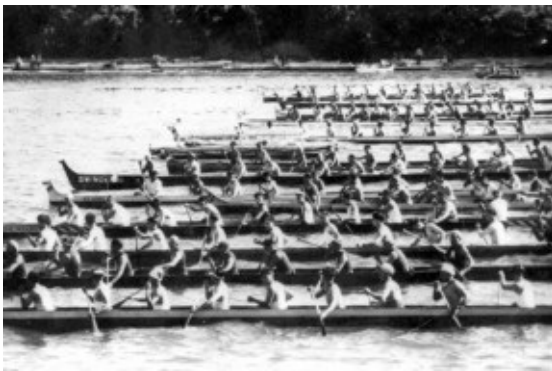

Platypus Has Left the Wharf!

The Port of Coupeville worked with the Department of Natural Resources Derelict



Vessel Removal Program to ensure proper removal of the Platypus, an approximately 45-foot wood, Australian WWII era, power boat. The Port received numerous phone calls from interested parties across the nation, but ultimately it was discovered to be unsalvageable. We are grateful for everyone's assistance in removing the vessel from Penn Cove, where it had become unmoored and run aground several times.

24 Front Street Has a New Roof!

When you visit the Coupeville Wharf, take notice of the new cedar roof on the historic Gillespie Meat Market located at 24 Front Street! We are grateful to have received grant funding from the Ebey's Forever Preservation Grant which supported half the cost! Next, we will be pursuing funding for a facelift to the front façade!

Greenbank Farm Is Exceptional & So Are Our New Interns!

The Port of Coupeville has partnered with Oak Harbor Exceptional Academy, an Oak Harbor Public Schools program, to support our educational programming at Greenbank Farm! The program assists students with job skills training, utilizing internships with local businesses here on Whidbey Island. Students work with an onsite job coach to gain the skills needed for transitioning to adulthood, employment, and independent living. We are thrilled to have Dawson and Brittany, along with their job coaches, join us here at Greenbank Farm to assist us with our upkeep of the grounds and facilities!

Welcome Dog Walkers!

New signage has been posted at the Greenbank Farm entrances leading to the off-

leash recreation area. This is to remind dog walkers that dogs must remain on-leash until the red flags marking the entrance to the off-leash area is achieved. Parking lots, businesses, and the playground are in the on-leash areas to ensure the safety of all, including our loved companions. Additionally, fenced agricultural areas are not open to the public. We ask that you pay attention to all signage and rules at Greenbank Farm to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all guests. We continue to experience complaints from visitors, so please pick up after your pet and do not walk any dogs off-leash that are not trained to your commands. Please note anyone breaking the rules may be banned from the Greenbank Farm.
