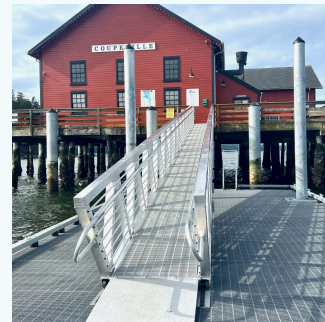
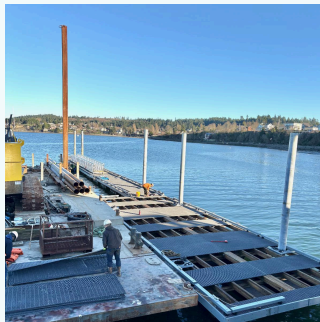
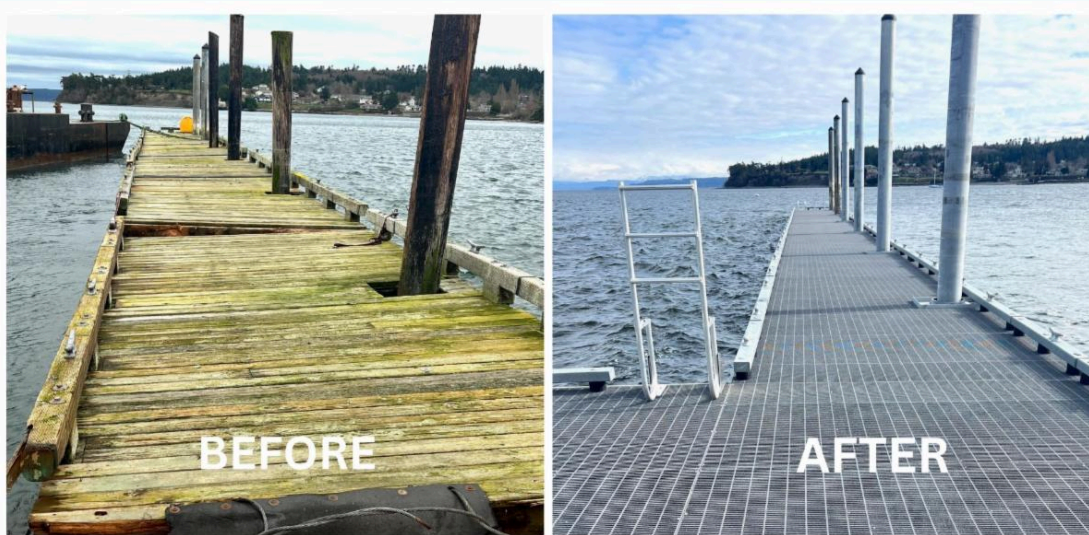


New Coupeville Wharf Dock

The new Coupeville Wharf dock is open. Shout out to Carlson Construction for their good work— that included installing the new dock before the fish protection period began in mid February.

The dock rehab completes a multi-year project to renovate the historic Wharf. This dock was made possible by Port of Coupeville IDD tax funds (see article below) — thank you!

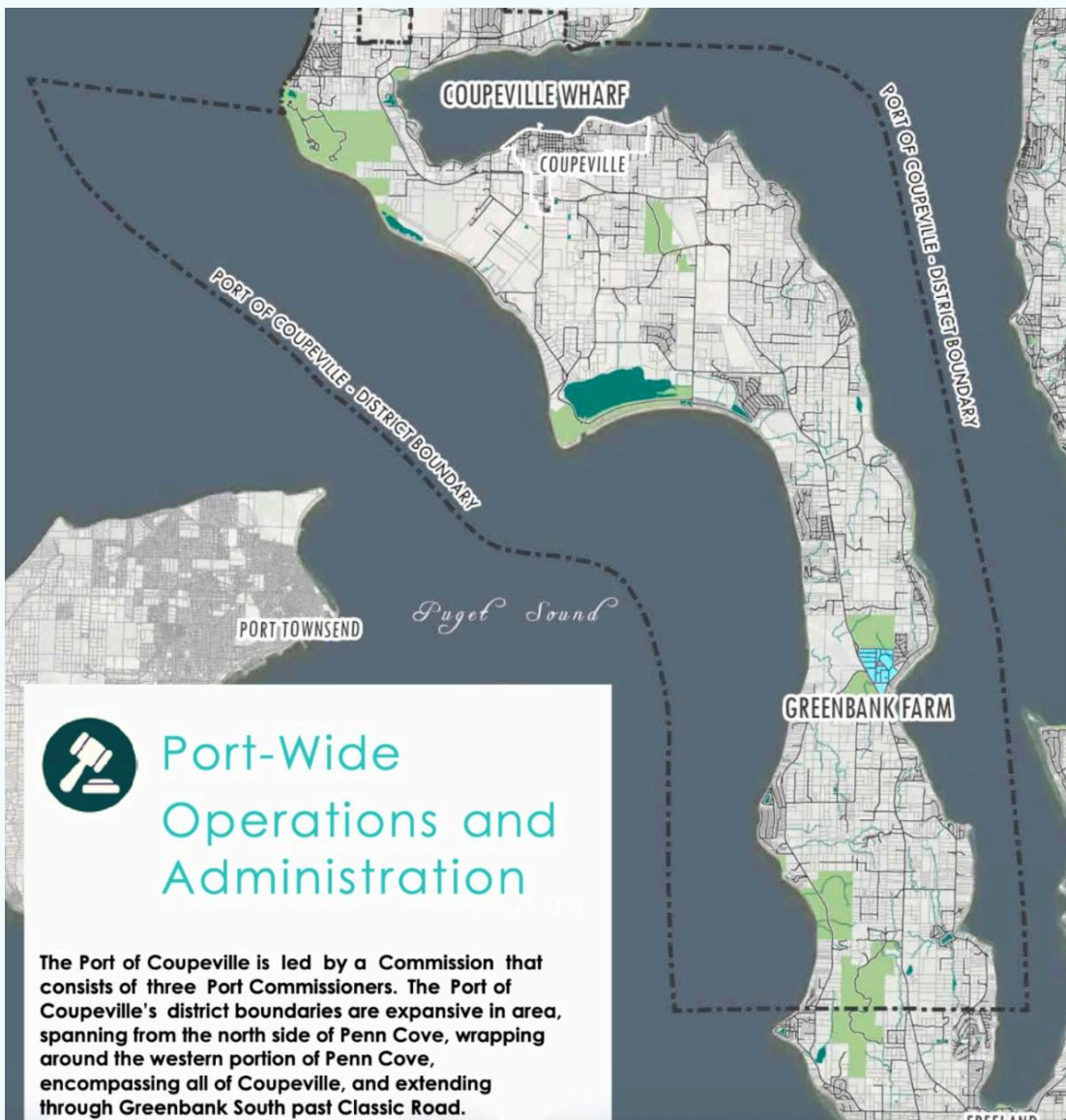
Port of Coupeville 1966 – 2026 History Highlight

Industrial Development District (IDD)

This year marks the Port's 60th anniversary, and each month we're highlighting info about the role that the Port plays in the Whidbey Island community + economy.

The Port of Coupeville is comprised of three districts, each represented by an elected commissioner. In 2021, the Port commissioners adopted an IDD tax levy, which began collecting funds in 2022. IDD funds are directed at much-needed infrastructure capital improvements for the Port's historic properties: Coupeville Wharf, 24 Front St, and Greenbank Farm.

IDD funds paid for the \$600,000 cost for the new Coupeville Wharf dock. The dock has an expected lifespan of 50-60 years.



Port-Wide Operations and Administration

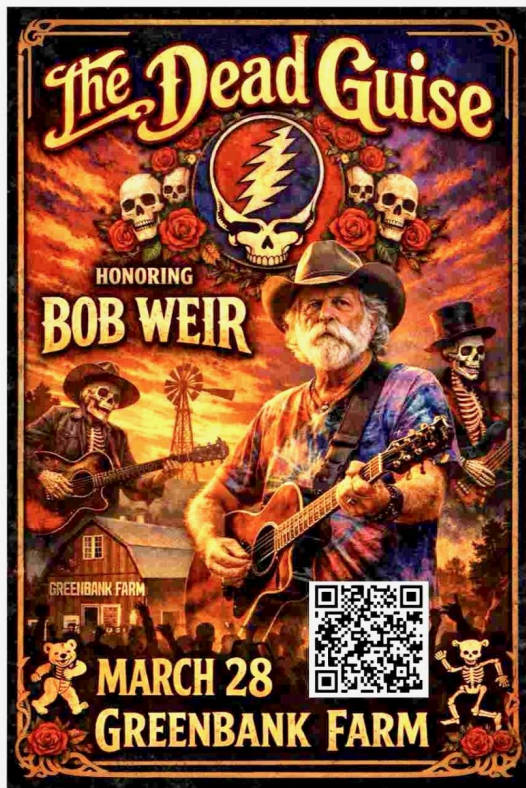
The Port of Coupeville is led by a Commission that consists of three Port Commissioners. The Port of Coupeville's district boundaries are expansive in area, spanning from the north side of Penn Cove, wrapping around the western portion of Penn Cove, encompassing all of Coupeville, and extending through Greenbank South past Classic Road.

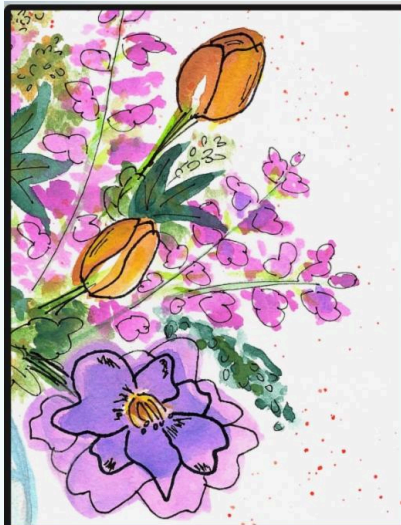

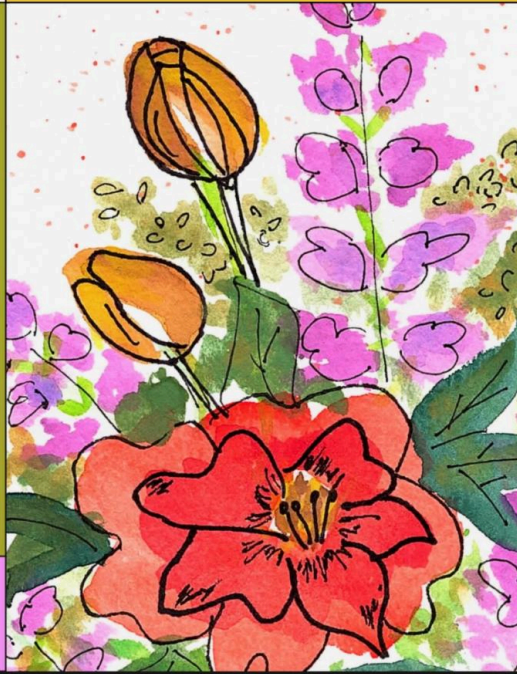
